Passes: Please find enclosed your allocation of 5 Personnel Passes.

Venue Access: Access to the Paddock Area for competitors will be via the Paddock Entrance from 14.00 Friday 14th June.

Paddock: Please park neatly in the space allocated to your championship / series without wasting space. Private cars and non-essential vehicles should be parked outside the Paddock gates and not in the main Paddock area. All vehicles and team equipment is left at the owners risk and neither the organisers nor circuit operators can be held liable for any loss or damage, howsoever caused.

Signing On for Competitors: This will be located in Race Control as detailed on the timetable. All drivers must provide at Signing-On;

- Motorsport UK Competition Licence and where applicable the Motorsport UK Entrants Licence
- Valid Club Membership (where applicable)

Scrutineering: This will take place in the Scrutineering Bay as detailed on the timetable. At Scrutineering drivers must provide;

- Competition Car
- Paperwork from Knockhill Motor Sports Club Officials confirming driver has signed on
- Crash helmet, HANS device (if appropriate), visor or goggles and overalls
- Vehicle Identification forms (if required)
- MOT/road fund licence (if required)

Drivers Briefings: Mandatory drivers briefing will be held in the Media Centre as follows;

SLS – 08.00 Saturday (new drivers only)

BMW & NSSCC – 08.30 Saturday

JSCC – 09.00 Saturday

Timings: All timings will take place in accordance with the published timetable.

Circuit Access: Access to the Circuit for all sessions will be via the Assembly Area. All cars will be noise tested in compliance with Motorsport UK General Regulation J.5.17-18 prior to being released onto the circuit. It is the Drivers responsibility to be ready at least 15 minutes before their timetabled session. Scrutineering labels must be affixed to the vehicle and clearly displayed before it is allowed onto the track. Drivers should go to the Assembly Area 15 minutes before published times and then when directed by the marshals they should proceed onto the circuit.

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Track Limits: The track limits are defined in Motorsport UK General Regulation Q.14.4.2. Cars reported as exceeding the track limits may have their lap time disallowed or be penalised with a time penalty.

End of Track Session Procedure: At the end of each track session, all vehicles must slow down and enter the Pitlane following the marshals instructions to return to the Paddock / Parc-Ferme area as required.

Information: The organisers will try to run the programme as published, but they reserve the right to delay or bring forward event times to suit the conditions of the day. Copies of practice times, provisional results & official bulletins etc will be available from Race Control. Power and timing monitor points are installed along the pit wall.

Entry List: Please check your entry on the enclosed list and notify us immediately if it is incorrect, this will ensure an accurate programme. If you are forced to withdraw be sure to advise Race Control. Any vehicle or driver change must be given to the Secretary of the Meeting before signing on for the Stewards' approval.

Awards Presentation: An awards presentation will take place in the Paddock Bar approximately 30 minutes after the conclusion of track activity. Please can all competitors attend to congratulate the award winners.
