NEW DRIVERS' BRIEFING NOTES

WELCOME

On behalf of the BARC, welcome to Silverstone for what we hope will be a very enjoyable race weekend.

ASSEMBLY AREA LOCATION & PROCEDURE ONTO CIRCUIT

Please refer to the general Driver Briefing Notes for the procedure. Please ensure that you get to the Assembly Area in good time before your qualifying session so that you can be noise tested before going out onto the circuit.

PIT LANE

When entering the pits, please keep to the right of the white line denoting the pit lane entry
The speed limit in the pits is 60kph. Please ensure you know where the limit starts and ends.
There are lights at the pit exit. Do not pass these lights if they are showing red.
When leaving the pit lane, please keep to the right of the white line

START LIGHTS - LOCATION

The Start lights are on the Gantry crossing the track. Start delayed boards may be shown from the gantry.

END OF SESSIONS

After taking the Chequered Flag you should reduce speed, complete a further lap of the circuit, enter the pit lane and proceed to Parc Fermé.

PARC FERMÉ

No work on the car may take place in Parc Fermé and no team personnel may enter unless under the instructions and control of the scrutineers.

RED FLAG

In the event of a Red Flag in qualifying, slow down and return to the Pit Lane. Should a Red Flag be shown during a race, cease racing and return to the grid, stopping short and following the instructions of the marshals.

LIVE RECOVERY

Silverstone Circuit is licenced for Live Recovery. Please watch out for yellow flags and lights.

SAFETY CAR

The Safety Car will enter the circuit from the Pit Lane exit and leave the circuit via the Pit Lane entrance.

SIGNALLING BOARDS AND FLAGS

These will be shown at the Control Line, which is after the last corner.

TRACK LIMITS

Instances of drivers exceeding track limits may be reported by appointed Judges of Fact. Judges of Fact will be at Copse Exit, Stowe Exit and Club Exit. Additional Judges of Fact locations may be advised during the meeting.

TIMETABLE

We will endeavour to run the race meeting to the timetable, but we reserve the right to run up to 20 minutes ahead of schedule. Please keep an eye on the programme and listen out for any paddock announcements. Silverstone has a strict curfew time. Please help us to maintain the timetable by ensuring you are in the correct place at the right time
