Silverlake C1 Racing Series

Safety Car

For clarification, MSUK Yearbook regulation Q Appendix 3, 1.6 (Page 301) states that competing cars are to be no more than 5 car lengths apart and are required to maintain the same speed as the safety car. If there is a large gap between you and the cars in front, you are required to catch up with the queue by speeding up in a safe manner until you have reached the cars in front. Overtaking of the safety car or any other competing cars is forbidden unless signalled to do so by the safety car observer.

The race will only be restarted once the whole grid of competing cars have formed an orderly queue behind the safety car.

As per the C1 regs 2.8.3, when the safety car is withdrawn, competitors must obey the 5 car length rule and may not overtake each other until they have passed the green signal at the start line.
