PICKUP TRUCK RACING CHARGERS RETURN TO MALLORY PARK

The Pickup Truck Racing Championship speeds back to Mallory Park this Sunday for the second and final time this season, with two races on the famous Oval circuit set to headline the day's track action.

Marking the halfway point of what has already been an ultra-competitive 2021 season, the return to the Leicestershire venue will undoubtedly prove to be pivotal in deciding who is crowned champion come the end of the year.

At the top of the standings, a mere 34 points cover the top three as it stands and it is Reece Jones that holds a slender advantage out front.

When the championship lifted the curtain on a brand new season here back in May, Jones came flying out the blocks with a superlative performance that netted him a pair of commanding victories.

Since then, the series leader has produced a consistent run of results which has seen him remain at the summit of the standings. He'll be hoping for a repeat of the results from earlier in the year to strengthen his advantage out front.

Hot on the heels of Jones is 2019 champion George Turiccki. Having not had the opportunity to defend his title last year due to the pandemic, Turiccki is living up to his mantle of reigning champion with a string of sensational driver - all of which have put him within 18 points of top spot.





The third driver to sit within touching distance is series stalwart Mark Willis. Armed with a wealth of experience, Willis has been steadily chipping away this year and looks in good shape to sustain his championship challenge.

Daniel Petters, Dale Gent, Michael Smith, Danny Hunn, Allen Cooper, Dean Tompkins and Nathan Dew round out the top ten and each one of them will be worth keeping an eye on over the course of the day as they bid to elevate themselves up the order.

Other notable drivers to look out for includes Lee Rogers, Paul Tompkins and Neil Tressler, whilst Mallory Park may also see the long overdue debut of British Touring Car Championship race-winner Matt Simpson.

With two blockbuster races scheduled to play out on the challenging Oval at Mallory, it is set to be a case of pull up a chair and don't take your eyes off the track when the Pickup Truck Racing Championship blast into life.

AVON TYRES NORTHERN & SUPER CLASSIC FORMULA FORD CHAMPIONSHIP MAKE A RETURN TO THE SPEEDBOWL

Fresh from their adventures competing at their two most regular venues, Oulton Park and Anglesey, the Avon Tyres Northern & Super Classic Formula Ford Championship makes a return to the speedbowl that is Mallory Park in Leicestershire for its third appearance of the season, as the Star of Mallory contest continues with more cash and testing voucher prizes on offers for the lucky winners.

All five classes are being represented here with a competitive entry in each setting the scene for what should be a fantastic day's single seater racing.

The previous two meetings in May both offered memorable moments and since then the respective rounds and Oulton Park and Anglesey have helped to shake up the points as the drivers head back to Leicestershire.

The P Class for the most modern Formula Ford chassis on the grid built between 1999 and the present day will see key rivals Jack Wolfenden and Nigel Dolan go head-to-head for only the third time this year. The pair have met on track at both the opening Mallory races and at Oulton, whilst also missing a weekend each, and now the pair are separated by 26 points before dropped scores but are now prepared to face stiff competition. This comes in the form of David McArthur, James Hadfield and National Formula Ford rookie Benjamin Cochran, all hoping to come away from Mallory with a result.

Paul Mason currently holds all the cards in Super Classic A and will be hoping to not just hold on to his advantage but to also extend it further, with a lead of almost 60 points. With the nearest rival in attendance being Neil Hunt's Mondiale down in 5th in class at this stage, Mason looks set to extend that lead further this weekend.

Super Classic B will once again be the most populated out of the five competing with seven cars ready to line up. It looks set to be a duel between Nick Barnes and "Juiceie Bruceie" for the honours this year as Nick leads Bruceie by just eight



points with the pair ready to lock horns once more. Richard Ketterman, Edwin Hannah and Leanne McShane will all give chase, as will defending class champion Peter Daly, the BRSCC chairman once again competing on his local circuit.

It's effectively certain that Super Classic C will gain a new points leader come the end of the day, as none of the current top three drivers are present on the entry list. Highest placed attendee is Ben Hadfield in 4th, along with 5th placed man Stuart Kestenbaum and Alan Fincham down in 8th. Expect all three to make big gains and really shake up the order.

The same can't quite be said for Super Classic D however, as despite Ian Fernihough also not set to compete on Sunday, his current lead of almost 100 points over second place can't be surpassed. Even if the Hawke of Simon Hadfield were to win both races with pole and both fastest Iaps, the most he will do is extend his gap over the rest of the pack, and to do that he'll have to beat both Mark Bates and Samuel Harrison in the process.

CRUNCH TIME FOR 2CV RACING CHAMPIONSHIP

Every point will be crucial in the 2CV Parts.com Championship this Sunday as the popular one-make series descends on Mallory Park for the penultimate event of what has been an action-packed 2021 season.

With the coveted 24-hour race at Snetterton set to bring down the curtain on the current campaign in the coming weeks, this weekend's visit to Leicestershire is set to be make or break for a number of title contenders.



BARC RACE MEETING MALLORY PARK

Multiple champion Pete Sparrow finds himself in the box seat heading to the business end of the season as he holds a 90-point lead over his nearest challenger. Bidding to regain the crown he lost last year, Sparrow has been nothing short of perfect so far with wins at Cadwell Park and Brands Hatch.

In truth, had the Pembrey round not been cancelled then Sparrow's advantage at the standings summit could have been even greater.

Relentless consistency has been the cornerstone of Kris Tovey's charge so far and his impressive form sees him sit second on the leaderboard.

Hot on his heels is the trio of Sandro Proietti, Nick Crispin and Luca Proietti - all of whom are split by just five points and primed to throw themselves further into championship contention.



Throw into the mix the likes of David O'Keeffe, Matthew Hollis, Mick Storey, Marc Grasby and Chris Yates and you can see why the battle for supremacy is far from done with just yet. With two races scheduled to play out around the sweeping curves of Mallory Park, edge-of-the-seat entertainment is guaranteed and it definitely isn't to be missed.

CARBON8 COUPE CUP WITH TOYO TIRES PREVIEW

Two years after it made its race debut here at Mallory Park and at the Coventry MotoFest in 2019, the third generation of Hyundai Coupe Cup race cars has come of age in 2021!

After going on a serious diet, the Gen3 was developed further and tested mercilessly during the remainder of 2019 and whenever possible in 2020. It is now at a level where it is competitive against the existing first and second generation race cars.

Fast forward to now and the Gen3 has already racked up two race victories, two pole positions, two fastest laps, and four other podium finishes. The Gen3 has definitely proven itself to be a worthy addition to the Coupe Cup.

However, at Thruxton in July, Lancaster Insurance backed Alex Cursley and his Gen1 proved that there is life in the old dog(s) yet.



Despite the added pressure of running two other Cursley Motorsport "Arrive & Drive" cars, he put his car on pole position and took dominant wins in both races over the weekend. Cursley finished over 13 seconds ahead of James Goodwin in the first race and only Misty Racing's Matt Mitter gave him any pause for thought in the second race. However, with Mitter receiving a 5-second time penalty, Cursley took the chequered flag over 5 seconds in front of a charging Wayne Rockett who dragged his Gen2 Coupe into second place after starting the

race at the very back of grid.


There are now three or four of the third generation of Coupe Cup cars and more are being built now that they have shown just how competitive they can be. Throw these into a mix with 20+ Gen1 & Gen2 cars and you're in for a treat at Mallory Park this weekend.
