Don't discount those just behind in the title race however, who won't be far from the action. Barry White sits third in the Sigma 150 standings, whilst Andrew Whitton and Gideon Wilkinson currently share fourth place, with 178 points apiece, with Rob Warner nibbling at their heels.

## CNC HEADS RETURN TO CROFT AFTER 5 YEAR BREAK

Not sure how this has happened but we have to look back to June 2016 for when the CNC Heads Championship last visited Croft. It is difficult to judge how large the entry will be as I write this piece as Covid is still affecting the preparation for some. Whilst we are now free to race almost as normal, there are issues with getting parts for cars and getting testing sorted. This caused the entry at our previous round a Cadwell Park to be significantly reduced, hopefully with things getting easier we will have more on the grid this weekend.

At the head of the field the Sakers of Paul Rose, Steve Harris and Dave Clark are out again after missing Cadwell. Croft is more suited to them than the twists and turns of Cadwell. Hopefully Simon Allaway will give his superb Lotus Esprit another outing and over the longer straights here push the Sakers hard for overall honours.

Double winner from Cadwell, Paul Dobson, in his 'fire-breathing' Locost 7 will probably be battling, as usual, with the Spire of Jon Woolfitt and perhaps the Caterham 420R of Richard Hall. Unfortunately the other Spire of Danny

Moving to the Modified Classes, in Class D Garry Wardle is entered in his Porsche GT3 but don't be surprised if he wheels out his Seat Cupra that he used at Oulton Park earlier this season. Oliver Thomas is back out in his Subaru Impeza along with 'Newcomer of the Year 2020' Ric Walker in his BMW Mini Cooper.

Perhaps the closest class battle of the day will be in Class E with current Champion Jamie Cryer trying to

consolidate his overall championship lead by taking as many class points as possible. Look for the immaculate Citroen Xsara of Paul Rotheroe and Steven Parker's BMW Compact to give Jamie a hard time.

Unfortunately Class F has suffered from a lack of support this year but regulars Helen Allen and Graeme Smith will be out to gain as many points as possible.

At the time of writing I am not sure if spectators will be allowed in the Paddock, but if you are come along and talk to the drivers (safely please).

# RUDMAN RULES THE ROOST AS LEGENDS CARS SEASON ARRIVES AT CROFT

Unmistakable cars, huge grids and amazing action - there really is nothing else quite like the Legends Cars National Championship with MRF Tyres, which arrives at Croft this weekend for rounds seven and eight of the season writes Marc Orme.

With 18 races complete, and 30 still to go, everything is to play for. Having said that, former champion Miles Rudman has begun to edge away from his rivals after a very impressive opening three events.

Ahead of the six races this weekend in North Yorkshire, the 2019 champion holds an advantage of 550 points over Will Gibson with five victories to his credit thus far. It'd be difficult to bet against Rudman continuing his rich vein of form.

While his lead is healthy, with 200 points available for a win the picture can quickly alter. Don't forget too, at the outset of this weekend's action there is a possible haul of 1,200 points available for any one driver and with grids drawn by ballot the



action is mesmerising. Gibson, who has three wins under his belt in 2021, moved up into second in the championship last time out at Brands Hatch during the huge American Speedfest. Third in the standings is five-time champion John Mickel who, with four race wins, is 115 points behind Gibson.

Sean Smith, who had a year away from racing in 2020, is fourth in the title battle from fellow series mainstay Jack Parker - the latter already a race winner this year. Consistency has been the watchword for Nick Bridgeman and he has been

rewarded with a top six championship placing. During the first meeting of the season at Cadwell Park he claimed a richly deserved maiden victory.

Other winners this year include Steve Whitelegg, who has two victories, multiple Masters Cup winner Paul Simmons and Chris Needham.

Reigning champion Daniel Clark, meanwhile, is still seeking his first win of the season and where better than at his 'home' track? Clark, from Darras Hall, is also joined by his wife Elby - the sole female racer in the Legends Cars National Championship.

## MAJOR BATTLE FOR MINI TITLE CONTINUES

The Quaife MINI CHALLENGE Trophy continues to deliver spectacular action on track, with the championship battle finely poised as the series arrives at Croft this weekend for the fifth meeting of the season.

As has seemingly become the norm so far in 2021, the most recent event at Oulton Park delivered another twist in the fight for top honours

after points leader Matt Hammond extended his advantage at the top with a lights-to-flag victory in the opening race.

However, that win - his fourth of the year - was followed by a heavy accident in race two that leaves question marks over whether Hammond will be able to defend his lead this weekend, with his participation being dependent on the EXCEL88 team being able to prepare a replacement car and on Hammond being medically cleared to compete.

Once dropped scores are taken in account, Hammond's provisional lead at the top currently sits at 19 points over PerformanceTek Racing driver Dominic Wheatley, who scored a pair of podium finishes last time out.

Wheatley had now picked up six podiums so far this season but has yet to make it onto the top step, something he will be eager to achieve this weekend at his home circuit.

Defending champion Harry Nunn maintained his consistent points scoring campaign at Oulton Park with a fourth podium finish to keep pace with the leading pair, whilst Charlie Mann now holds fourth on the back of a strong weekend that saw him



break onto the podium, having shown front-running pace throughout the season to date.

Alex Solley and Lewis Saunders round out the top six, the latter having provisionally taken his first win in the series in the shortened second race at Oulton Park to move up the championship standings.

Ricky Page sits level with Saunders but won't make the trip to the North East this weekend, with Louie Capozzoli only a handful of points behind and keen to try and get into the top six himself. Alfie Glenie, Nicky

Taylor, Nathan Edwards are amongst the other drivers who will have an eye on fighting towards the sharp end having shown flashes of speed across the season so far.

A 31 car field expected to hit the track for the two 20 minute races this weekend including local driver Dave Marshall, who earned his place on the grid after winning the MINI CHALLENGE eSeries title.

With such a bumper grid of equally matched cars, expect action at every quarter across the two 20 minute races this weekend.

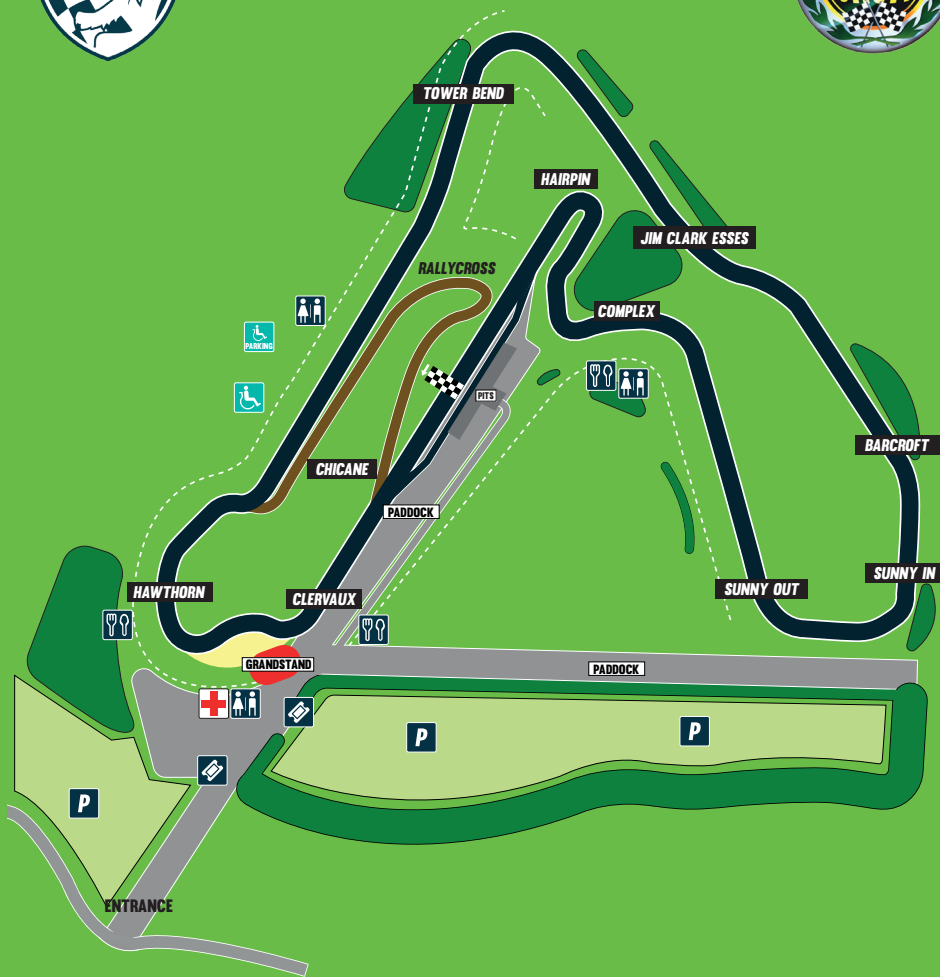
