With immediate effect, the following amendment is to be made to the official Championship Regulations already issued for the above Championship. All additions are underlined and in red text. Where appropriate, deletions are shown in blue strikethrough. Italics are used as notes and do not amend regulations.

Regulation Clarifications:

1.5 CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS:

The Championship is scheduled to be contested over <u>19</u> 20 Rounds at 9 Meetings as follows:

5.13 TYRES:

5.13.1 Specifications:

- a) f) are unchanged
- g) Restricted to 8 new tyres at the first meeting (4 dry with barcodes and 4 wet without barcodes) and thereafter 2 new tyres per meeting <u>except where 3 races</u> are scheduled (Silverstone & Pembrey) when 3 new tyres per meeting are permitted. Only 6 tyres can be nominated for Qualifying and Races and this must be done before qualifying begins <u>except when 3 races are scheduled (Silverstone & Pembrey) when 7 tyres can be nominated</u>. The 4 Wet tyres issued at the first meeting will come without a barcode and these tyres can be used without any

judicial penalty if the Clerk of the Course declares the Qualifying or Races as "Wet Sessions".

Reason:

The change to 1.5 is due to the cancellation of the Saturday afternoon program at the Brands Hatch meeting. With 3 Rounds at 2 of the 4 remaining meeting and tight timetables at the other 2 meetings no space could be found to replace the lost Round.

The change to 5.13.1.g is due the pressure on tyres when running 3 Rounds at a meeting. It is felt that an additional tyre will give more margin to cover a wider scope of eventualities.
