Overview

The BARC Competitions department is restructuring. One of two similar roles, the successful candidate will be responsible for delivery of approximately half of the club's non-BTCC events. This will include high-profile, national and club race meetings and support for other competition department activities, such as Goodwood.

Responsibilities include:

- Responsible for professional delivery of BARC national race events
- Creation of essential event competitor and officials' documentation
- Ensure adherence to Motorsport UK, H&S and internal procedures to safely run race events including booking medical, rescue and recovery services for events
- Development of collaborative relationships with championships
- Liaison with venues and race circuits

- Monitor and manage event staffing before and during events
- Communication with championships and officials to ensure smooth delivery of events
- Ensure post-event paperwork and financial reconciliations completed after each event
- Plan layout of, and oversee setup of, paddocks at events
- Regular attendance at race meetings and other events throughout the season
- Manage ad hoc projects for the Competitions department to improve customer service
