# CLASSIC TOURING CAR RACING CLUB **READY TO RACE**

The Classic Touring Car Racing Club lifts the curtain on a brand-new season with a club record entry set to do battle around the Silverstone International circuit this weekend.

Rolling back the years to bygone eras of tin top entertainment, the CTCRC is renowned for producing plenty of excitement and that is once again set to be the case this year; especially as two new categories will debut alongside the six other established championships.

Eagerly anticipated by many is the arrival of the Laser Tools Super Tourers, which evokes memories from one of the most revered periods in BTCC history. Iconic machines such as the 1998 title-winning Volvo S40, 1998 Nissan Primera and a 1996 Ford Mondeo are confirmed, as are a number of period stars too.



Two-time champion John Cleland will be back behind the wheel of his Vauxhall Vectra whilst Anthony Reid will be reunited with his Primera. Other notable entrants include four-time champion Colin Turkington, Jason Hughes and Jason Minshaw.

It's a new era for Jaguar saloons and GTs as the newly-named Jaguar Challenge roars into life. A grid of 25 big cats has been confirmed with reigning champion Michael Seabourne leading the entry as he targets a second successive crown.

The oldest cars in action over the course of the weekend will be found in the Poultec Pre-'66 Touring Cars. With everything from Hillman Imp's to Ford Anglia's, this series is set to take fans on a spirited trip down memory and it isn't to be missed.

James Ibbottson ruled the roost last year and he returns to defend his crown however he will need to be at his best as the likes of former champions Patrick Harris and Luc Wilson, amongst many others, will be on the hunt for silverware.

Another hotly contested category will be the Orange Aero Pre-'83 Touring Cars where a grid of Ford Escort's, Volkswagen Golf's and more will go wheel-to-wheel. Multiple champion Stephen Primett continues to be the benchmark and after reclaiming his crown in 2021 you can imagine he has no intention of

relinquishing it. Both the Laser Tools Pre-93 Touring Cars and Burty Pre-03 Touring Cars have delivered edge-of-the-seat entertainment down the years and 2022 should be no different.

Notable names to keep an eye on across both days includes Ian Bower, David Griffin, Gary Prebble, Steve Barber and Graham Myers.

Elsewhere, those with a passion for Ford's will be able to see plenty in action courtesy of the Burton Power Blue Oval Saloon Series whilst some of the most powerful, flame-spitting saloons will duke it out in the Edmundson Electrical Classic Thunder Championship.

Boasting a bumper entry list and with a season-long fight for the Club's unique prize-money structure up for grabs, this weekend's Silverstone opener shows all signs of being a real classic, pardon the pun!

The evergreen Mini 7 racing club makes its seasonal debut this weekend with packed grids full of tin-top experts all fighting for glory in these iconic pocket-rockets

## MINI MIGLIA

In the top-tier, power-packed category, former BTCC Champion Andrew Jordan will be looking to defend his hard-won title from last season. Up against him are the likes of Jeff Smith, himself an ex-BTCC frontrunner and now triple Mini Se7en Champion making the step up to the 1293cc formula, along with several former class titleists including Aaron Smith, Rupert Deeth, Kane Astin and Endaf Owens, the latter carrying the number '0' to signify his 2021 O-Plate Winter Challenge triumph. Don't be surprised to see the likes of Chris Morgan, Colin Peacock and Ashley Davies in the hunt, while Larry Warr and Phil Bullen-Brown have shown recent form in Historic Mini Coopers.

## MINI LIBRE

A strong line-up in the invitational class sees a variety of A-Series



set-ups, including the 8-porter of 2020 champion Dan Lewis and the 1380 5-port example of 2018/19 winner Phil Harvey, with Richard Colburn (5-port) and Peter Hills (16V) having also scored wins last season.

## MINI SE7EN

With Jeff Smith moving to Miglias, the full-race

'heritage' formula should see a new champion this season. Likely favourites for this accolade are the two drivers to have run Smith the closest in recent times, Spencer Wanstall and Joe Thompson who between them have several race victories under their belts, although former British GT/TVR Tuscan/BTCC winner Mike Jordan will be hoping to capitalise on his excellent race-winning start in the 1.0-litre class last season.

Glen Woodbridge is a dark horse too, while dad Paul is making a return after a few decades away, and will be in good company with other experienced campaigners

including Graham Penn and Tina Cooper.

## MINI-7 S-CLASS

The milder-tuned 1275cc 'feeder' category sees an ever-growing line-up, and is headed by Michael Winkworth after an impressive record-setting 2021 championship-winning season. His closest rivals are all back to take him on again, led by Damien Harrington, Matt Ayres and Ryan Taylor, the latter not only racking up top Under-17 honours for the second time but also securing the class Winter title too. Several other Mini specialists are also in the line-up, Ben Butler, Dave Rees, Ben Seyfried and Steven Rideout having all won in other categories.





# SILVERSTONE PRIMED FOR BLOCKBUSTER BMW BONANZA

The 2022 Kumho BMW RDC season will start at Silverstone this weekend with qualifying on Saturday and two races & Sunday.

The championship is open to any production based BMW produced for sale to the general public in Europe, either right or left hand drive and includes the early 2002 turbo's and iconic "Batmobile" supercars, through to the latest models. A number of BMW mini's raced as "Invitation" with us last year but will contest two classes in the full championship in 2022,

with a realistic chance of providing the overall champion.

This year looks to be a tight contest with previous champion James Card and fellow Class A front runners, Brad Sheehan & Darren Morgan-Owen taking on reigning champion Kevin Denwood in his Class B car. The mini's should add interest & spice to the pot being an

unknown quantity after only qualifying for points this year. Bryan Bransom must be in with a shout being local to Snetterton & therefore racing twice at his home circuit. Ian Crisp is returning to the championship and is usually at the sharp end of the action, together with Michael Vittuli and Jason West, while Russel Duck & Trevor Ford will surely be pushing Kevin for the Class B honours.

having celebrated 25 years as the title sponsor in 2021.

Initially run on Kumho production tyres, after discussion with competitors, the decision was made to change to slicks & wet tyres in recent years in view of increasing power and performance. This makes the championship arguably, one of the fastest and safest in the country, attracting the cream of BMW competitors to race in a championship where driving standards and technical regulations are rigorously enforced to ensure equality and safety. Also, the ease of access to cars & drivers for spectators always ensures a convivial atmosphere in the paddock.

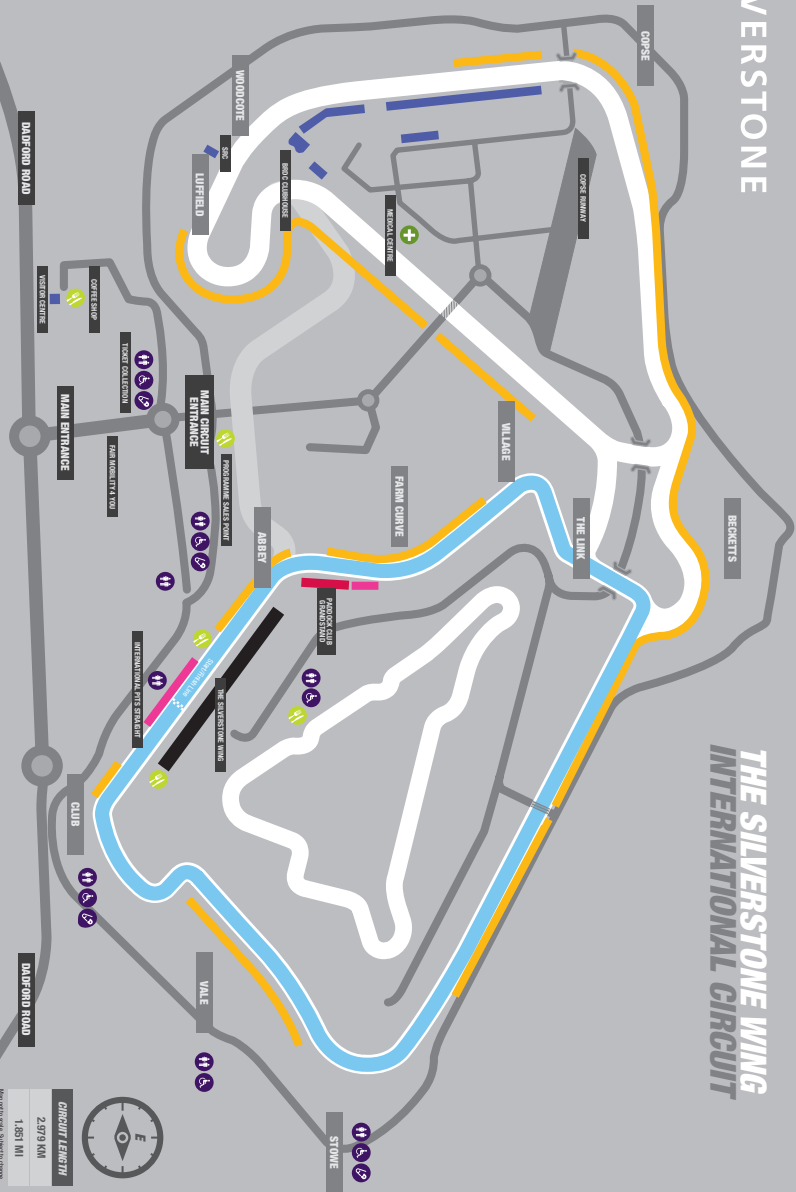
