Brief Details:

Car 784 made contact with Car 777 at the apex of the left hand part of The Vale causing car 777 to spin into the gravel and retire from the race. Car 784 continued.

Under C2.3 gaining an unfair advantage whether inadvertently or not I add 30 seconds to your overall race time.
