Onboard video from Truck number 2 showing contact with the drivers left rear quarter of Truck 28. Truck 28 was on the racing line and the video shows Truck 2 being off the circuit on the tarmac run off to the left-hand side of the entrance to the second element of the 'Complex'. The contact resulted in both trucks spinning off on to the grass at the 'Complex'.
