Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Championship Regulation(s):

3.18 Gaining an advantage- Due to testing within 14 days prior to the championship round at the same circuit.

## ***Brief Details:***

Driver of car 11 breached championship regulation by testing at Donington prior to the event within 14 days.

It is not permitted for any Competitor to test at the venue within the period of 14 days prior to the championship event taking place at that venue. The only exceptions to this rule are a) when testing is scheduled to take place at the venue for all "junior" drivers and b) prior to the first round of the season

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
