Q12.21.4 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car

### **Brief Details:**

Car 23 made contact with the side of car 20 whilst proceeding round the Melbourne Hairpin causing car 20 to lose control and several places in the race. Onboard footage of car 20 & 23 reviewed and both drivers advised of their right of appeal.
