The Stewards have received a petition from Ryan Smith for them to review, in accordance with Article 14.1.1 of the International Sporting Code 2023, decision 5 made by them at the Round 1 of the British Truck Racing Championship Competition:

The Stewards, having examined the in-truck video footage of driver #1, technical information, and heard from Elizabeth Stannard and Shaun Stannard determine the following:

**Decision:** there is no significant and relevant new element which was unavailable to the parties seeking the review at the time of the decision concerned.

Reason: It is the opinion of the Stewards that the element brought before us was not significant or relevant to call in to question or modify the initial decision. The Stewards find that from Cooper Straight to Clearways corner Driver #1 did not maintain his correct station. This meant by the time of exiting Clearways driver #1 could not maintain the requisite distance to the truck in front, driver #89. The Stewards have no evidence that driver #14, the pole position driver, was over the maximum permitted speed limit.

The Stewards also find that this element was not new as it was not explained why it was unavailable to driver of #1 at the time of the decision concerned.

The Right of Review therefore fails and decision number 5, in relation to driver #1, is upheld and stands.
