MARSHAL AND OFFICIAL'S INSTRUCTIONS

1.1 GENERAL

1.2 TICKETS, CAMPING PASS & MARSHAL ACCESS

ENTRY TICKETS

Your wristband, complimentary ticket(s) and car park label (or camping passes if requested) have been sent to you (or are currently on the way to you) – they were posted on Monday 3rd April. The entry wristband is valid for both days (Sat & Sun) and is your means of entry; it is to be worn continuously. The printed lapel ticket(s) are passes for your guest(s) and there is one for each separate day for which you have volunteered.

CAMPING and CAMPING PASSES

Goodwood have invested significant time and effort into resolving the issues that some marshals and officials experienced on the campsite during the meetings last year. As part of this, security arrangements have been significantly changed. Marshals/officials and competitors are now being sent camping wristbands in addition to the Campsite car pass. For those who have requested a camping pass, two “camping wristbands” are included with your tickets. (One for yourself and another for your guest). This must always be worn on the campsite.

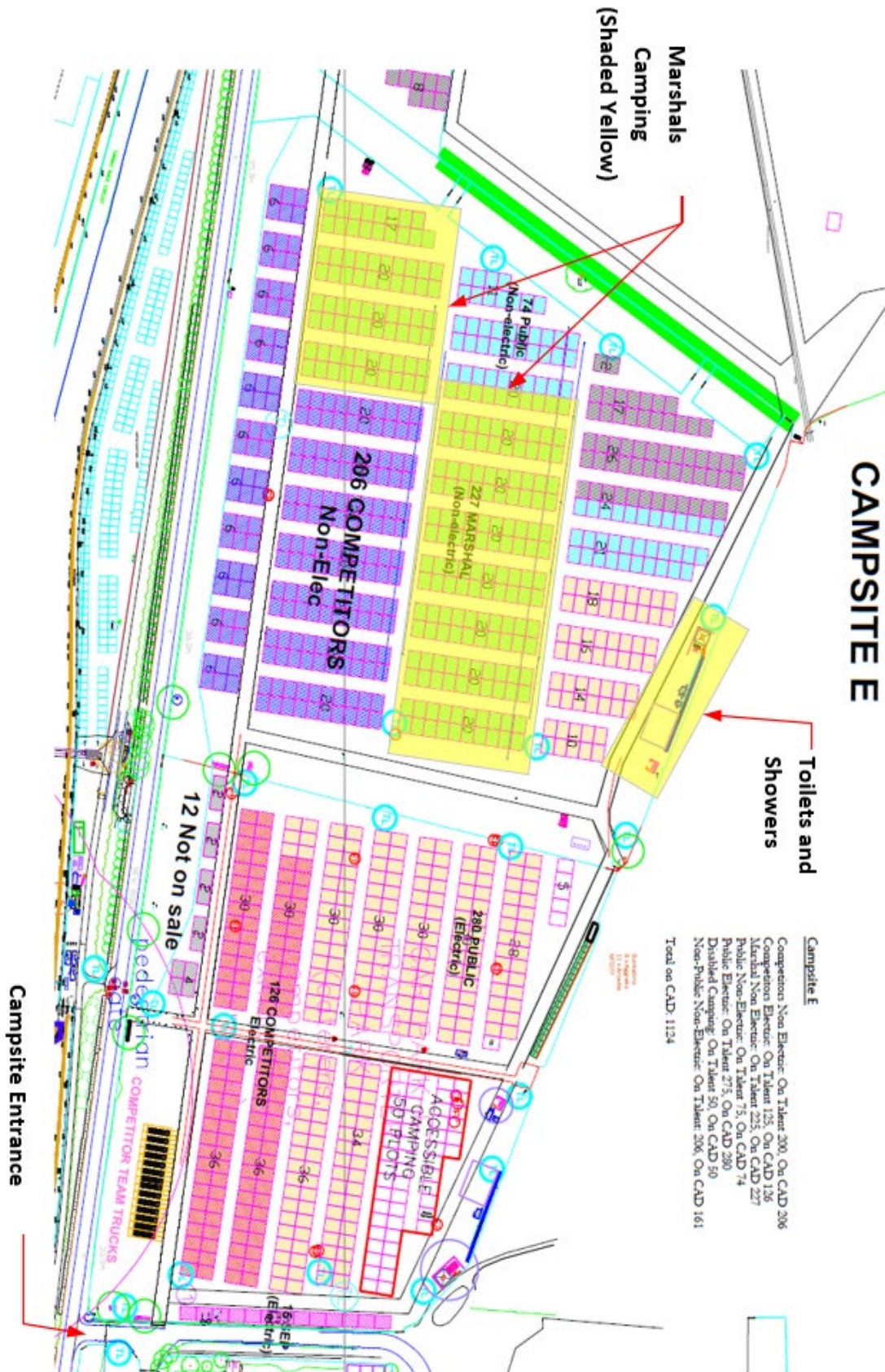
If you did not request a campsite pass when volunteering, and now require one, please contact Josh Bennett, Volunteer Manager, at the BARC office. Availability for those not having previously requested a camping pass is extremely limited and passes will be issued on a first come first served basis. (Please note due to the Bank Holiday, any new camping requests need to be made to Josh by close of business Wednesday 5th April at the latest).

Marshals and officials have been allocated a specific area within the campsite (see campsite map below). It is therefore important that you follow the instructions from the campsite manager and campsite staff when you arrive and it is really important that you do not setup in another area, or camp outside of the Marshals designated spots.

There are contact numbers on the showers and toilets, as well as the campsite office, should any issues arise.

In addition, Alan Stalker (Chief Marshal) and Mike Whitney (Deputy Chief Marshal) have kindly agreed to act as liaisons with the Goodwood's campsite manager about any issues that occur. However please use the contact numbers on the facilities in the first instance before contacting either Alan or Mike. (Alan's contact details are in the contacts section, 1.18, below).

The Camp site is open from Thursday for those officials working on the Friday, and from Friday for all others.



MARSHALS ACCESS TO THE CIRCUIT

Marshals are able to access the circuit from 07:00 via Gate 12 from Competitors Car Park 'D' the other side of the Lavant Road near Woodcote Corner. (This is adjacent to the Campsite, see below). There is also a bus service operating on the campsite that goes to the main entrance, subject to weather and ground conditions.



Please note: Your guest can only access the circuit from 07:30hrs with their daily complimentary ticket the same as spectators. Anyone attempting access prior to 07.30hrs using a guess ticket will likely be refused entry.

Marshals and their guests may, if they choose, also park in the public car park opposite the Main Gate (See Event Map at the end) and access the circuit via the pedestrian entrance. Again, access to those with guest passes is not permitted before 07:30hrs.

MARSHALS LUNCH & BREAKFAST VOUCHER

As in previous years, Goodwood have generously provided a packed lunch and bottle of water which will be provided at sign-on/check-in (see locations/times below). In addition, Goodwood are also kindly providing a breakfast voucher this year on Saturday. The voucher can be used from 06:30 – 11:00 at the Goodwood Staff Welfare unit (located as below) or any mobile catering unit and is valid for a bacon or egg bap and tea or coffee.





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1.3 OFFICIALS/MARSHALS SIGN ON

Marshals and officials will not sign-on at the meeting having previously completed signing on electronically using the BARC Rev-Up system. The Rev-Up system will be your acceptance of the sign-on declaration for both Motorsport UK and the ACU. (Both declarations can be viewed through Rev-Up).

However:

All **Track Marshals/Fire/Rescue Crews** must see the Chief Marshal who will be in the area behind Woodcote Corner between the times below to confirm their attendance. (See Map above under Marshals Access to the Circuit).

Please collect your radio (if appropriate), packed lunch, breakfast voucher (Saturday), and water from the same place after checking in. Check-in will commence at 07:00 **not before**.

All **non-track personnel** (i.e. Pits/Startline/Assembly Area/Parc Ferme/Senior Officials etc.) will check-in outside the Ultimate High Building (see below) adjacent to the Assembly Area to confirm their attendance.

Please collect your radio (if appropriate), packed lunch, breakfast voucher (Saturday), and water from the same place after checking in. Check-in will commence at 07:15.



All **Recovery Unit** personnel will check in/sign on at the Circuit Office in the pitlane at the appropriate time. (Please contact Gabriel Ludlow or Sam Fairweather at the circuit if you need to confirm times/locations).

1.4 POST CHIEF BRIEFING

An in-person Post Chiefs briefing will take place at the Marshals Signing-On tent at the times above. **Attendance is mandatory for all Post Chiefs.**

1.5 RADIOS

Post Chief radios will be issued at Marshal check-in. Post Chiefs will also be issued with a full headset, this must be worn/used with the radio. Details for the collection of Radios for charging will be communicated each day. The headset should be retained overnight on Saturday and returned on Sunday together with the Radio.



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Radios for all other duties (except Paddock and Scrutineers) will be issued from the Ultimate High building adjacent to the rear of the Assembly Area. Radios issued from here must be returned to Ultimate High each evening for charging. Again headsets/earpieces should be retained overnight Saturday and returned on Sunday to Ultimate High.

Paddock and Scrutineers radios will be issued by the Chief Scrutineer and Chief Paddock Marshal along with instructions for charging/return etc.

1.6 SPECIAL WHITE OVERALLS & DRESS CODE

The following procedures will apply, all under the control of BARC / Goodwood Staff.

- White overalls will be issued to all people who require them at Posts 1, 2F, 19F, 20, 21F, 22, 23F & 24 at Marshals sign-on each day. They will all be numbered, and numbers allocated to names. They must be returned to Marshals Sign-on on Sunday evening.
- Starline, Assembly Area, Paddock and Parc Ferme overalls will be issued at the Paddock office by Daniel Smith and returned to the same location.
- Anyone, not attending on Sunday, please ensure you return any white overalls you have been issued with, Saturday evening to the place of issue.
- The overalls are 'Proban' material.

Observers and flag marshals may dress in "Country Casual" style (i.e. tweed jacket and tie) rather than overalls if they wish.

Senior Officials, Race Administration and Race Control the dress code is white BARC shirts.

Any Marshal/Official who would like to look around the paddocks and other areas at convenient times must remove their overalls and be suitably dressed. While there is no formal dress code for the Members Meeting, we *politely ask you to refrain from wearing denim and trainers*. USE OF CAMERAS OR MOBILE PHONES WHILST ON DUTY IS PROHIBITED, unless it is necessary to send a report to Race Control.

1.7 AVAILABILITY

Unfortunately, we are unable to accept anyone else on any day. Please advise the BARC office if you are unable to attend by returning your passes and instructions to **VOLUNTEER MANAGER, BARC, THRUXTON CIRCUIT, ANDOVER, HAMPSHIRE, SP11 8PN.**

If you find, at a late stage, that you are unable to attend a phone call to either Josh at BARC HQ or the Chief Marshal would be appreciated. (All contacts are below in section 1.18).

1.8 MARSHALS COACHES

Coaches will be parked on the track to take Marshal's to their posts from 07:45 on both days. Those in the Pits/Paddock area, and at nearby posts (1-2 and 20-24) are advised to walk to their location. Coaches will collect Marshals at the end of the day after the last session dropping at Woodcote corner.

1.9 SPECIAL CIRCUIT RULES

The Duke of Richmond is very keen to continue the special feel of this meeting, which can only be achieved by everyone paying strictest attention to the smallest detail. Therefore, your full co-operation is vital in this matter. However, we are sure that you will all be keen to enter the spirit of this event and will thoroughly enjoy yourselves.



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No post 1985 vehicles will be allowed into the circuit, other than those previously authorised (e.g. Rescue Units, Breakdowns etc.) these must not be parked anywhere around the Start/Finish section, or in the Paddock. Rescue Units, Fire cars and Breakdowns must immediately be taken to their post after sign-on and may then only go on track under the direct instruction of Race Control. It will not be possible to switch locations between sessions.

1.10 SATURDAY EVENING ENTERTAINMENT

Marshals and officials are invited to attend the Saturday evening entertainment which will include food, music, and fireworks. Please note, white or orange overalls are not permitted while attending this event.
