Q11.3.1 Mobile phone or tablet devices are prohibited from being carried in the competing vehicle whilst on the circuit.

### **Brief Details:**

Whilst sitting in the vehicle parked at the side of the circuit, the driver failed to leave the vehicle when instructed by marshals endangering himself, marshals and fellow competitors whilst using a mobile phone.
