Brief Details:

Car 117 made contact with the rear of car 53 in the braking zone of Wilson causing car 53 to lose control and several positions in the race.

Onboard footage of car 117 and 53 viewed and an interview was conducted with the post chief at post 4.

5 seconds to be added to car 117 overall race time

As per championship regulation 4.2.2 (iii) - A 3 place grid penalty will be served at the next race.
