Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

C2.3 Gaining unfair advantage (whether inadvertently or not)

Brief Details:

Car 52 made an overtake on car 888 whilst yellow flags were displayed on circuit. After reviewing the footage and driver it was clear that the overtake did happen however, it appeared that the sun was in direct view of the marshal post blocking the drivers view. This was supported by the driver of car 888 who congratulated car 52 on a cracking overtake. Due to this mitigating factor, the position is to be reverted under "gaining an unfair advantage" so a 1 place penalty is being issued to the driver of car 52.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

C2.3 - 1 place penalty

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
