## **Brief Details:**

Contact was reported at the chicane on the last lap between cars 9 and 42.

Both drivers were interviewed individually with their footage and then spoken to together. Footage shows contact as reported, as both cars entered the chicane.

Having investigated this incident with the evidence available, I do not believe that any further action is necessary on this occasion. Drivers verbally informed of decision at 17:41hrs
