Following investigations I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK regulation:
Q12.21.4 - Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car.
Additional Information / Reasons for Decision:
Car 62 made avoidable contact with car 22 at the hairpin causing car 22 to lose a position in the race.
Onboard footage of car 22 \& 62 viewed and both drivers/entrants interviewed.
As per championship regulation 4.2.2 (ii) a 2 place grid penalty will be served at the next available race
Both drivers have been reminded of their right of appeal.

Accordingly under G5.3.3, I order that you:


2 Penalty points are recorded on your licence as a result of above

* If your practice times are dis-allowed above, you may, in accordance with Q12.9.4., start the race from the back of the grid with a mandatory 10 second delay or start from the pitlane on the first racing lap.
