



DRIVERS BRIEFING NOTES

Croft – 12th & 13th August 2023

CIRCUIT INFORMATION

Circuit Length	3.411 km/2.100 miles Clockwise
Pole Position	Right Hand Side
Assembly Area	At the end of the paddock on Outside of First Corner
Parc Ferme	Left in Pit Lane after Race Control, before Assembly Area
Pit Entry	Drivers Left after Hairpin
Pit Exit	Drivers Right onto Pits Straight
Start Lights	Drivers Left on the gantry
Clerks Flags	On the Pit wall near Pole Position
Pitlane Speed	60 kph

SIGNING ON

Online prior to event.

SCRUTINEERING

Scrutineering - Keith will be in the paddock to scrutineer cars on Friday afternoon. For those that do not get scrutineered on Friday, the times will be:

08:30 (Sigmax/Sigma 150) and

10:00 (Sigma 135) on Saturday in Scrutineering Bay.

ASSEMBLY AREA PROCEDURE ONTO CIRCUIT.

Please make sure you are in the assembly area at least 20 minutes before your session is due to start. Noise Testing may be carried out on entry to the Assembly Area.

Entry to the Circuit is Straight out into Turn 1

For **Qualifying**, you will be released from the Assembly Area onto the Circuit.

For **Races** you will leave the Assembly area in Grid order behind the Safety Car and be lead round, but cutting through the Gap after Tower and onto the Grid, You will then be shown the 1 Min / 30 Second Board and Green Flag, you will proceed around the whole circuit and return to the grid, once all cars are in position you will receive a 5 Second Board, then the Red Lights will come on and 2-7 Seconds later be switched off to signify the Start of the Race. You should not overtake on the Green Flag lap, unless a car in front is slowing down to pull off., and you should maintain a reasonable pace.

All Races are set by Qualifying Times:

- Race 1 by Fastest time in Qualifying,
- Race 2 by 2nd Fastest time in Qualifying
- Race 3 by 3rd Fastest time in Qualifying

If you have any problems on the grid, please try and wave your hand so the marshals can see you.

START GRIDS

Be aware that other signals such as Race Delayed may be shown from the Startline Gantry. The race will start when the Red Lights go out.

Starting Grid will be a 2 x 2 formation

False Starts are deemed as:

- Moving before the Red Light goes out.
- Out of grid box markings i.e. In front of or to the side of it

The Penalty is a **10 second race time penalty**, notified from Startline during Race.

LAST LAP BOARD

I will arrange for a last Lap board to be displayed from the Startline at the start and duration of the Races Last Lap.

END OF PRACTICE/RACE – PROCEDURE FOR LEAVING THE CIRCUIT

At the end of all your sessions you will take the Chequered Flag and slow down, complete a whole lap and exit the circuit into the Pitlane and on into Parc Ferme.

QUALIFYING/RACE STOPS

If your **Qualifying** gets red flagged, you must slowdown sufficiently and return to the pit lane unless marshals tell you otherwise.

If you have a red flag during the **Race**, you cease racing and return to the grid unless told otherwise, which will automatically become Parc-Ferme.

DRIVING STANDARDS

At all times show respect and consideration for your fellow competitors and all marshals and officials., obeying all Flag /Light signals.

Do not flaunt the track limit regulations. Remember rules have changed since 1st June 2023, and it is any part of the contact point of any tyre crossing beyond white line or rear of kerbing. There will be appointed Judges of Fact at locations on the circuit. Just to remind you of the track limits penalties, these are what they will be:

During Qualifying if you are reported to have breached track limits you will have that lap time disallowed

Race penalties

1st Offence - No action

2nd Offence - Black and White Flag

3rd Offence - 5 Second Time Penalty

4th Offence - 10 Second Time Penalty

5th Offence - Drive Through Penalty (*Observing Pit Speed Limit*)

6th Offence - Black Flag (Disqualification)

If you inadvertently gain an unfair advantage on track, at the earliest possible moment give back that advantage.

Track Limits will be monitored by a Judge of Fact at:

- Turn 1 Clervaux, Post 2
- Turn 2 Hawthorns, Post 3
- Turn 9 Jim Clark Esses, Post 11

Should your vehicle develop a mechanical problem whilst on track, and particularly if it is dropping fluids, please leave the track as soon as it is possible and safe to do so.

SAFETY CAR

The Safety Car can be deployed as per Championship Regulations, please ensure you have read and understand the procedure.

The Safety Car will join the circuit from the pitlane exit, and will leave the circuit by the Pit Lane Entrance. Overtaking during the Safety Car is not permitted until you have passed the Startline, on the Green Flag.

LIVE SNATCH

Croft is licenced to carry out Live Snatch at Turn 1 Clervaux, these will be covered by waved yellow and white Flags/Lights, please take extreme care under these conditions. All other recoveries will be carried out under Safety Car conditions.

ON BOARD CAMERAS

Please ensure that all onboard cameras are switched on and have a card in them prior to Qualifying and Racing, it is an offence as per Championship Regulation 2.13 (iv) not to have a working Camera. There are Mandatory Championship fines for not being able to supply footage.

Incidents on circuit are not always seen by Post Chiefs, and reported, or in fact seen differently than what actually occurs. If you have anything that you want me to look at,

ensure that you let me know on the day, as I am unable to act days or weeks after the event, if you advise Vicki of this, she can advise me via our communication links.

All cards maybe be collected after Qualifying and / or each race, and if required to be viewed and will be returned to you prior to the next session.

JUDICIAL PROCESS

The judicial rules and regulations are exactly as described within the Motorsport UK Yearbook except that everything will be undertaken electronically rather than producing pieces of paper.

Therefore, if you are involved in a judicial hearing a decision will be announced to you and then sent by emailed to your registered email address.

Protests and Appeals can be made in the usual way through either the Secretary of the Meeting or the Senior Clerk of the Course using the electronic form which is available from the Secretary (email addresses at foot of these notes)
