Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q12.21.4 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car

### **Brief Details:**

After reviewing footage of an incident between cars 4 and 29 it was determined that car 4 was at fault for causing a collision. Car 4 had taken a narrower line with usual speed compromising the exit and drove into the rear of car 29 causing car 29 to partially lose control and ultimately lose the position. A verbal warning was issued.
