Additional Information / Reasons for Decision			
Car 30 and Car 11 made side to side contact on the approach to Copse Corner. Car 11 made contact with the barrier drivers left and retired, Car 30 continued. Marshals report from Post 18 recieved and reviewed. Onboard footage viewed from Cars 11, 30 and Car 23 which was directly behind 11&30. Team Manager of Car 11, driver and team manager of Car 30 interviewed. As a result I consider that neither driver was wholly or predominantly to blame.
