Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q12.21.4 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car

Brief Details:

There was contact reported regarding car 38 and car 110 which caused car 110 to lose control and spin. After reviewing the footage from car 110 and car 38 the following can be found. Car 38 appears to understeer into car 110. There is a gap between car 38 and 110 at the breaking point. Car 110 takes their normal line through the corner. After interviewing the driver of car 38, they said that they went or the overtake as the door was open. It is the opinion of the clerk that the door was always going to close due to the gap between the cars being to large and that the driver of car 38 should have anticipated this act.

Due to the above, the driver of car 38 is awarded a formal reprimand and 2 points.
