1.1 MARSHAL AND OFFICIALS' INSTRUCTIONS

1.2 GENERAL

This meeting will be held under the following Motorsport UK and ACU permit numbers:

Please take the time to read all parts of these instructions as there is important information throughout.

1.3 TICKETS, CAMPING PASS & MARSHAL ACCESS

TICKETS

Your wristband, complimentary ticket(s) and Car Park D or Camping passes (if requested) have been sent to you. The wristband is valid for all days (Friday, Saturday, and Sunday) and is your means of entry, to be worn at all times. The printed ticket(s) are passes for your guest(s) and there is one for each separate day for which you have volunteered.

CAMPING and CAMPING PASSES

If you have not requested a campsite pass when volunteering, you will require one if you wish to camp, please contact the Volunteer Manager, Josh Bennett, at the BARC office. (Please note availability for those not having previously requested a camping pass is **extremely** limited).

With the campsite pass you will also have been sent a pair of camping wristband as well. (One for yourself and another for your guest). This is your personal access to the campsite over the weekend.

Goodwood have invested a significant effort into resolving the issues that marshals, officials, competitors as well as the public experienced on the campsite during the meetings earlier this year and last year. As part of that work a designated area has been set aside for Marshal/Officials camping as per the map below.


To make these changes work, please follow the instructions from the campsite team at all times. Do not setup in another area, even if you have camped there previously, or camp outside of the Marshal' designated spots.

There are some other important points to note around changes to the campsite. These are:

- The campsite is open from 12 noon on Thursday until 12 noon on Monday.
- You will need to check-in on arrival at the Campsite Office between 12 noon and 10pm on Thursday and 7am to 10pm on other days.
- The Campsite Office is located near the main entrance to your campsite and is manned 24 hours a day from 12 noon on Thursday until 12 noon on the Monday.
- Each 9m x 7m pitch is for up to four people.
- Your vehicle must be parked within your allocated pitch.
- Only one car is allowed per pitch. Due to recommended fire regulations, cars are not permitted to be within three metres of a sleeping unit (tent/campervan/caravan etc). If you are travelling in more than one car you will be asked to park additional vehicles in the public car parks.
- Use of your vehicle should be kept to an absolute minimum during your stay. A vehicle curfew will be in place
 from 10pm till 7am. No car movement will be permitted in this time. Anyone witnessed to be driving
 inappropriately in the campsites may be charged a grass reinstatement fee by Goodwood based on the amount
 of damage to the grass. The minimum charge is £250.

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
- Users of the campsite are not expected to endure noise deemed to be a nuisance between 10.30pm and 8.30am. Please be considerate to your neighbours. Persistent noise offenders will be removed from the campsites.
- A courtesy shuttle service of tractors/buses will run daily from 7.30am to 10.30pm.
- A dedicated 24-hour security team is in attendance at Revival from 12 noon on Thursday until 12 noon on Monday. Goodwood has installed a CCTV network to monitor the site. The network is monitored by Goodwood's Security Team at all times. If you experience a breach in security or any act of anti-social behaviour please report it immediately to one of the security patrols, or directly at the Campsite Office.
- All guests are welcome to use the barbecues. Those using disposable barbecues must use bricks from the
 Campsite Office to allow your barbecue to be clear of the grass, reducing the risk of fire. Please ensure that
 these are returned after use as there are a limited number to service the entire campsite.
- If any issues arise, please contact the Campsite Office in the first instance.



ACCESS TO THE CIRCUIT

Marshals are to access the circuit from 07:00 via Gate 12 from Car Park D/Camp Site 'E' the other side of the Lavant Road near Woodcote Corner.

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Please note - Your guest can only access the circuit from 08:30hrs with their daily complimentary ticket. Anyone attempting access prior to this time using a guest ticket will likely be refused entry.

Marshals and their guests may, if they choose park in the public car park opposite the Main Gate and access the circuit via the pedestrian entrances. Again, access to those with guest passes is not permitted before 08:30hrs.

1.4 OFFICIALS/MARSHALS SIGN ON

Marshals and officials will not sign-on at the meeting having previously completed signing on electronically using the BARC Rev-Up system. The Rev-Up system will be your acceptance of the sign-on deceleration for both Motorsport UK and the ACU. In addition:

All **Track Marshals** must check-in with the Chief Marshal who will be in the area behind Woodcote Corner between the times below to confirm their attendance. (For location see map above).

Please collect your radio (see below), packed lunch, breakfast voucher, and water from the same place after checking in. Check-in will commence as per the table below **not before**.

An in-person Post Chiefs briefing will take place at the Marshals Signing-On tent at the times below. <u>Attendance is mandatory for all Post Chiefs</u>.


Rescue and Fire Crews

Please collect just your packed lunch, breakfast voucher, and water from the BARC Sign-On tent. You will then check-in with Martin Hunt (Rescue Chief) for your specific briefing. (Details to be forwarded separately). Radios for Rescue, Ambulances and Fire Cars will be delivered from Ultimate High. (Please ensure they are returned there for charging each evening).

All non-track personnel (i.e. Pits/Startline/Assembly Area/Parc Ferme/Senior Officials etc.) will check-in outside the rear of Ultimate High Building adjacent to the Assembly Area to confirm their attendance.

Ultimate High is shown in the map below.

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Again, please collect your radio (if appropriate), packed lunch, breakfast voucher, and water from the same place after checking in. Check-in will also commence as per the table below.

<u>Recovery Unit</u> personnel will check in/sign on at the Circuit Office in the pitlane at the appropriate time. (Please contact Gabriel Ludlow or Sam Fairweather at the circuit if you need to confirm times/locations).



1.5 MARSHALS LUNCH & BREAKFAST VOUCHERS

Lunches

As in previous years, Goodwood are providing a packed lunch and two bottles of water which will be provided at sign-on/check-in. (i.e. BARC Sign-On and Ultimate High). In addition, there are water standpipes located at the catering outlets approximately behind Posts 3, 7, 8, 13, 14, 18 as well as infield (See below).

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All marshals and officials are **strongly encouraged** to bring re-usable water bottles and fill up at these standpoints whenever possible and ensure that any single use plastic bottles are disposed of in the appropriate recycling containers around the site.

Breakfast Vouchers

In addition, Goodwood are kindly providing a breakfast voucher for each day this year. The Goodwood Operations Team have stated that the "vouchers should be accepted at any mobile catering unit across the site. Marshals may be turned away by mobile caterers if they have too many orders to take any more, however there are catering units also on Hurricane lawn and OTR which will be open in the morning from 7am." Again, these will be provided at the two Sign-On locations.

1.6 RADIOS

Post Chief radios will be issued at Marshal check-in. Post Chiefs will also be issued with a full headset, this must be worn/used with the radio. Details for the collection of radios for charging will be communicated each day. The headset should be retained for the duration of the weekend and returned on Sunday with the Radio.

Radios for all other duties (except Paddock and Scrutineers) will be issued from the Ultimate High building adjacent to the rear of the Assembly Area. Radios issued from here must be returned to Ultimate High each evening for charging. Again headsets/earpieces should be retained for the duration of the meeting and returned on Sunday to the same location.

Paddock and Scrutineers radios will be issued by the Chief Scrutineer and Chief Paddock Marshal along with instructions for charging/return etc.

1.7 WHITE OVERALLS and DRESS CODE

The following procedures will apply, all under the control of BARC / Goodwood Staff.

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- White overalls will be issued to all people who require them at Posts 1, 2F, 19F, 20, 21F, 22, 23F & 24 at Marshals check-in each day.
- Paddock and Startline overalls will be issued at Paddock Control by Dan Smith.
- Overalls will all be numbered, and numbers allocated to names. They <u>must be returned</u> to check-in on Sunday evening. (Should anyone not be Marshalling on Sunday, then please return the overalls to Check-In, on your last day at the event).
- The overalls are 'Proban' material.

Observers and Flag Marshals may dress in period costume rather than overalls if they wish.

There is a dress code for all spectators, which consists of a jacket and tie, a sports jacket, or double-breasted blazer with grey flannel or cavalry twill. Senior Officials are encouraged to wear a Trilby, flat-cap, or bowler. Ladies are to wear period dress with the hemline below the knee. T-shirts and branded clothing of any type are forbidden. Umbrellas should be black and un-liveried/branded. Macs and overcoats are allowed with the exception of anoraks.

Any Marshal/Official who would like to look around the paddocks and other areas at convenient times must remove their overalls and be suitably dressed.

1.8 SPECIAL CIRCUIT RULES:

The Duke of Richmond and his team are very keen to continue the period feel of the meeting, which can only be achieved by everyone paying strictest attention to the smallest detail. Therefore, your full co-operation is vital in this matter. If because of this, you feel that you do not wish to attend the event please let us know as soon as possible. However, we are sure that you will all be keen to enter into the spirit of this unique event and will thoroughly enjoy yourselves.

No post 1965 vehicles will be allowed into the circuit, other than those previously authorized (e.g. Rescue Units, Breakdowns etc) these must not be parked anywhere around the Start/Finish section, or in the Paddock. Rescue Units, Fire cars and Breakdowns must immediately be taken to their post after check-in and may then only go on track under the direct instruction of Race Control. It will not be possible to switch locations in between sessions. Please note - Curfew for modern vehicles is between 07:30hrs – 20:30hrs on Friday and between 07:30hrs – 19:30hrs on other days, any movements are to be via Gate 11.

PLEASE NOTE – **USE OF CAMERAS OR MOBILE PHONES WHILST ON DUTY IS PROHIBITED**, unless it is necessary to send a report to Race Control.

1.9 MOTORCYCLE SESSIONS

The same flag rules for cars apply to motorcycles, except:

- A Yellow flag with Black Cross will be shown to denote last lap. Note: A Le Mans type start will be used for Motorcycles as well.
- Black/Orange Flag will instruct the rider to pull off as soon as possible to safe place and not necessarily return to the Pit Lane.

A number of posts will have a marshal allocated to their teams who has a background in classic motorcycle racing, please welcome these marshals into the team and draw on their experience during the motorcycle sessions.

1.10 AVAILABILITY

Unfortunately, we are unable to accept anyone else on any day.

Please advise the BARC office if you are unable to attend by returning your passes and instructions to VOLUNTEER MANAGER, BARC, THRUXTON CIRCUIT, ANDOVER, HAMPSHIRE, SP11 8PN. If you find at a very late stage that you are unable to attend (i.e., less than 3 days prior) a phone call to either the office or the Chief Marshal would be appreciated (contacts below).

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1.11 TRACKSIDE CURFEW AND MARSHALS TRANSPORT TO POST

Due to current Civil Aviation Authority rules regarding flying displays, posts between Madgwick (Post 3) and Lavant (Post 19) cannot be accessed prior to at least 08:10 each morning as a curfew exists in these areas.

Marshals on these posts must either wait trackside at Marshals check-in where transport, see below, will take them to post as soon as the curfew has lifted, or to proceed trackside and wait at the course/safety cars that mark the start of the exclusion zone until it is safe to proceed to post.

As previous years military vehicles (JEEP and GMC) will be parked on the track at Woodcote corner to take Marshal's to their posts from <u>08:15</u> after the curfew, on both days. Those at nearby posts (i.e. Posts 1-2 and 20-24) are requested to walk to their locations after checking-in.

The vehicles will collect Marshals at the end of the day after the last session, dropping at Woodcote corner.
