Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q12.21.4 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car

**Brief Details:**

Incident involving car 99 noted in the race log. After minor investigation (live stream footage) it was determined that car 6 was involved. After interviewing the driver of car 6, it was determined that car 6 had tried to attempt an overtake in a gap that did not exist. This caused front to rear contact between car 6 and 99 rendering car 99 out of control (footage reviewed from car 6, 99 front and 99 rear).

It was determined during the judicial hearing that car 6 was at fault and responsible for the incident (admission during the hearing). Car 6 was awarded a formal reprimand for causing a collision and 2 penalty points (resulting in a 2 place grid penalty for race 2). The driver of car 6 was accompanied by their signed on parent and both were reminded of their right to appeal should they wish to do so.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Formal Reprimand (2 Points)  
Number of Licence Penalty Points: 2

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
