Car 2 gained an unfair advantage in the braking zone at Turn 2 (Druids)
 ITV footage viewed.
 On-board footage viewed from cars 1, 2, 31 and 42.
 Drivers and team managers from cars 1, 2 and 42 interviewed.

Accordingly I order that you:

- Have the following qualifying lap times disallowed (Q12.27)
 Have the following race lap times disallowed (Q12.27)
 Be penalised by the addition of 5 seconds to your elapsed race time (G5.3.7)
 Be penalised by the addition of position(s) to your race finishing position (G5.3.7)
 Be reported to the Stewards for alternative penalties (G5.3.7)
 No penalty points are recorded on your licence as a result of above
