Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q12.21.4 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car

### **Brief Details:**

Car 53 was reported running wide on the official race log. On investigation, it was determined that car 11 and 22 were involved. After reviewing video evidence from car 11, 53 and 12 (car behind) it was deemed that car 11 was predominantly at fault for the incident which caused car 53 to run wide. Car 11 took excessive curb (but remained within the limits of the track) which unsettled the front of the car causing it to understeer into car 53. The driver of car 11 stated that they were trying to give car 53 more room.

The driver of car 11 was awarded a formal reprimand and 2 points and was reminded of their right to appeal.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
