Following investigations I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK regulation:

Q12.21.2. / Q12.21.2(a) / Q12.21.2(b) – Exceeding Track Limits

Additional Information (Optional):

During the race driver 19 was shown black/white flag for track limits but clerk did not get message when it was shown. Reviewed in car footage with driver and could flag being shown and then afterwards further multiple track limits as per race log. On review could see two clear at old hairpin, and thus in race would receive a 5 second penalty.

Accordingly under Motorsport UK Regulations **G5.3.3** and **Q12.22.1(a) & (b)**, I order that in qualifying Practice you:

Have the following lap time(s) disallowed.(Q12.27)

Or in the Race you

- Be given a 5 second elapsed time penalty
- Be given a 10 second elapsed time penalty.
- Be given a drive through penalty
- Be given a 30 second elapsed time penalty in lieu of a drive through penalty
- Be disqualified from the results of the race.

No penalty points are recorded on your licence as a result of above.

* If your practice times are dis-allowed above, you may, in accordance with Q12.9.3., start the race from the back of the grid with a mandatory 10 second delay or start from the pitlane on the first racing lap.
