Following investigations I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK regulation:

**Q12.21.4 –** Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car.

Additional Information / Reasons for Decision:

On approach to mcleans, car 4 overtook car 19. he moved across in front of 19 before he was clear forcing car 19 onto the grass. In doing so car 19 spun across track and into car 18. On balance of probabilities, car 4 was responsible for contact as he took the line from 19 before being past.
