Additional Information / Reasons for Decision:

Exiting copice corner car 22 made contact with the rear of car 1 which caused car 1 to spin and make contact with the barrier.

Both drivers interviewed and in car footage seen.

	Be reported to Motorsport UK as a potential breach of the Respect Code
