Following investigations I find that you are guilty of contravening Motorsport UK regulation C1.1.6, namely:

Q.12.24.3 (e) Flashing/Waved Yellow - overtaking or not slowing down between signal and incident (Q12.24.5)

Additional Information / Reasons for Decision:

Set fastest sector 3 time and fastest lap

Accordingly under Motorsport UK Regulation G5.3.2, I order that you:

- Be given a verbal warning [0 points]
- Have the following lap times disallowed (Q12.27) Lap 9 - 2.09.821 [0 points]
- Be given this formal written reprimand (C2.1.1.a) [2 points]
- Be fined the sum of (Max £1,150) (C2.1.1.b) [3 points]
- Be given a place grid penalty effective on your next race (C2.1.1.c) [3 points]
- Be given a drive through penalty (Q12.26.a – g) [0 points]
- Be given a Stop / Go penalty Prescribed time of (Q12.26.a - g) [0 points]
- Converted in to a post race time penalty of (Q12.26.h) [0 points]
- Be penalised by the addition of to your elapsed race time (C2.1.1.c) [3 points]
- Be penalised by the addition of position(s) to your race finishing position (C2.1.1.c) [3 points]
- Be disqualified from practice and your practice times are disallowed* (C2.1.1.d) [4 points]
- Be disqualified from the results of the race (C2.1.1.d) [4 points]
- Be disqualified from the results of the meeting (C2.1.1.d) [6 points]
- Additional Championship Penalty:
- Penalty points are recorded on your licence as a result of above (C2.1.5, C2.1.7)

* If your practice times are dis-allowed above, you may, in accordance with Q12.9.4., start the race from the back of the grid with a mandatory 10 second delay or start from the pitlane on the first racing lap.

You are advised of your right of appeal.
