Following a hearing and after viewing video evidence, I hereby find that you are guilty of contravening Motorsport UK general regulation:

C 2.3 Obtaining an unfair advantage (whether inadvertently or not)

In that you shortcut the Chicane and gained an advantage on car 16 in doing so.

Therefore, under GR G5.3 and CR4.2, I order that you should be penalised:

- By the addition of a ... seconds to your race time for the result of Championship Round ...
- X By means of a one place penalty for the result of Championship round 11
- By means of a 3 place grid penalty applied on the next Championship round that it can be taken
- 0 No penalty points are awarded for this action however, you are reminded of your right of appeal.
