Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car concerned

Brief Details:

Contact between Car 17 and 45 at Turn 4, causing Car 45 to lose control and when correcting then car 45 collided back with Car 17 causing Car 17 to make contact with Car 62, all cars eventually continued. But Car 17 retired before the conclusion of the race.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Onboard footage from Car 45 and 62, and Live feed. Car 17 had left the circuit within the 30 Minutes from result, and was contacted by mobile on numerous occasions by myself and Jack Finlan (Championship co-ordinator) all calls unanswered, left answer message. Decision was carried out without the presence of the Driver of Car 17.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK NCR Ch.5A App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Be penalised by the addition of time to your elapsed race time (Ch.2, Ann. A, Art. 1.3) Number of Licence Penalty Points: 3

Additional Comments: 5 Second time penalty

Just to confirm this was carried out without the presence of Driver (Jake Hewlett), but emailed decision.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with NCR Ch.2 App.12 Art.1.1 (2.12.1.1).
