The stewaring panel heard from the 3 names above as 333 entrant and driver felt the decision was too harsh and it should be reduced to a racing incident.

The panel viewed the footage on board of car 333. Contact was clearly made between Car 333 and Car 42 which caused 42 to be disadvantaged and lose a position and in our view the contact was avoidable. The contact was not deliberate but, in our opinion, a penalty was justified and therefore we felt the decision should stand
