Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car concerned

Brief Details:

Car 333 and car 42 make contact.

Driver of car 333 and 42 interviewed. Footage from both cars front facing cameras reviewed. Driver entrants and championship safeguarding officer present.

Car 333 goes for an overtake on car 42 from a long way back. Car 42 continues to turn through the corner. Car 333 locks up and makes front to side contact with car 42. Car 333 did state that they attempted to give back any position gained but was unable to as car 42 did not get going straight away.

Car 333 issued a Formal Reprimand, 2 points and reminded of their right to appeal.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK NCR Ch.5A App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
