Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Championship Regulation(s):

Ch.2 App.8 Art.1.10 Eligibility - post practice scrutineering

**Brief Details:**

Car 13 sustained damage and lost a front wing in session one, session two immediately followed session one, the wing was still on the circuit. Therefore car 13 presented in contradiction of champion ship regulation 5.6.1.1 "A standard external appearance must be maintained at all times, except where deviations from this allow and are specifically mentioned in these regs".

The eligibility scrutineer has stated that he viewed the vehicle before session two and the vehicle was allowed to compete as the was no sharp edges, the vehicle was safe and there was no advantage to be gained by its condition.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK NCR Ch.5A App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
