Following a hearing and reviewing video evidence, I find that you are guilty of contravening,


**NCR 12.7.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car**

In that contact was made with car 52 on the straight which showed a lack of control of the car

Therefore, under NCR 2.2.2 and CR 4.2, I order that you should:

X	Be verbally warned
	Be officially reprimanded,
	Be fined a sum of £ . . . . . ,
	Be penalised by the addition of . . . . . seconds to your race time.
	Be penalised by means of a three place grid penalty for your next race
	Be disqualified from the results of the qualifying / race for championship round . . .
	This counts as a "strike", CR 4.4.5, carrying a further 3 place grid penalty
