Following a hearing and viewing video evidence, I find that you are guilty of contravening,

NCR 12.7.1.5.f More than one change of direction to defend, failing to leave space to the edge of the track, manoeuvre likely to hinder others

In that you did hinder car 123 in forcing that car beyond the edge of the circuit

Therefore, under NCR 2.2.2 and CR 4.2, I order that you should:

- Be verbally warned
 - Be officially reprimanded,
 - Be fined a sum of £ ,
 - Be penalised by the addition of seconds to your race time.
 - Be penalised by means of a place grid penalty
 - Be disqualified from the results of the qualifying / race for championship round
 - This is counted as a “strike”, CR 4.4.5, carrying a 3 place grid penalty
- Penalty points are awarded for this action, details of which will be recorded against your licence records. You are reminded of your right of appeal.
