**ANGLESEY INTERNATIONAL CIRCUIT**

On behalf of the BARC NW Centre, I would like to welcome you all for our first of two visits this year to the Anglesey circuit. I hope you all have a safe and enjoyable weekend of racing.

**There will be a MANDATORY face to face briefing for ALL drivers at 1030 on Saturday at the championship race centre. These notes are specifically for anyone that is taking part in the paid session prior to the briefing.**

Please familiarise yourself with the Final Instructions issued for this event, the BARC Standing regulations and the BARC H&S documents, all found on the BARC website. Please note that we are now governed by the National Competition Rules and for this event, we shall be using version 9 (Latest) of the NCRs. Any questions – please ask – ideally before the start of the day on Saturday. Contact details at the end of this note.

**Scrutineering**

Scrutineering will be available from 2pm until 5pm on Friday Afternoon, this will be done in situ.

Saturday morning scrutineering is in the scrutineering bay. Drivers taking part in the paid practice will need to be scrutineered prior to this at 0800. All drivers not taking part in the paid practice will be scrutineered at 1000.

**Assembly Area**

For those who have not been to Anglesey before; the assembly area is located between the scrutineering bay and the Med Centre. For paid practice you be called out of the assembly area and directed left down the pitlane. At the end of the pitlane there will be a red light, you must stop at the red light and only proceed onto circuit when you are shown a green light. Please pay attention to the Marshals instructions at all times.

**On circuit**

Please familiarise yourselves with the location of the Marshals whilst on track, paying particular attention to the flag signals. These will be different positions to ones used for mid-week test/track days. Track Limits are monitored at Turns 1, 2, 3 and 14.
