Additional Information / Reasons for Decision

Car 19 Overtook Car 28 on Lap 15 / 16 on the start finish straight under Yellow Lights. On interviewing both drivers both acknowledged that they had not seen the signal and only reacted to the Light at the entry to T1. In mitigation to both drivers the signal along the start finish straight is obscured bu an advertising hoarding.

Onboard footage from both vehicles was viewed in coming to the above decision.
