Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car concerned

Brief Details:

Whilst entering the Club Chicane car 78 made heavy contact with the rear of 53 causing car 78 to spin and make heavy contact with the tyre wall and car 76 to spin and continued.

The contact was avoidable and car 78 was wholly and predominately to blame for the contact.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Front and rear onboard cameras viewed from cars 78 and 76.
Driver of car 78 was interviewed.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK NCR Ch.5A App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Be given a grid place penalty effective on your next race (Ch.2, App.2 Art 1 (d))
