Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.5.f Manoeuvres liable to hinder other drivers such as deliberate crowding of a vehicle beyond the edge of the track or any other abnormal change of direction

Brief Details:

Car 23 forces car 19 of the track.

Video from 23 and 19 reviewed and both drivers interviewed.

Car 23 tried to move across to follow car 80 and made contact with car 19 which had come along side also following 80. Car 19 was forced onto the grass as a result.

Car 23 issued a formal reprimand and issued 2 points and reminded of their right to appeal.
