**Brief Details:**

Car 8 (Django Jones) and Car 69 (Luis Darling) on the first lap, approaching the first corner made contact causing Car 69 to turn and make contact with Car 23. On reviewing the footage from Cars 8, 69 and a evidence car. It was evident that car 8 did not leave enough room for car 69 when along side and this was the predominate factor in the causing of the collision. The decision was a formal reprimand to car 8 as the driver of the car was predominantly at fault for the incident.
