Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.2 App.1 Art.1.14, Ch.12 App.8 Art.1.7.m Failure to comply with black signals

Brief Details:

Pit Lane Speed Gun Judge of Fact reported car 1 travelling at 68kph in a 60kph pit lane. As per series regulations, the drive through penalty board was shown along with the black flag and the car number at the control line.

Car 1 passed the signal 6 times before it was withdrawn in order for other signals to be displayed. Driver of car 1 was apologetic and noted that although the need to look at the control line flag point each lap was specifically discussed at the driver briefing, they were concentrating on Turn 1 approach and did not look at said flag point.
