Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.2 App.1 Art.1.14, Ch.12 App.8 Art.1.7.e/f Failure to comply with yellow signals

Brief Details:

Marshals report form Post 5 indicated that car 3 overtook car 777 under yellow signal. On reviewing the on board camera footage this report was correct. From interviewing both drivers (3 and 777) the mitigating circumstances are car 777 had a engine warning light and had slowed to a minimal pace to manage. Car 3 in a faster category came up on the slow moving 777 at a controlled speed in line with yellow signal procedures. Car 3 overtook car 777 before the green light signal due to the beckoning of car 777. Verbal warning issued to not overtake under yellow signal.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Car 777 on board footage, marshals report and interviews with both drivers.
