Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Championship Regulation(s):

5.4.9 & 5.5.5 Engine & Turbo Change

Brief Details:

Car 100 presented documentary evidence from Cupra Spain detailing post event (Croft - June 14th & 15th) engine performance data, where Car 100 was involved in a significant impact incident. Car 100 has undertaken an engine change as detailed in the Engine/Turbo change documentation produced by Adrian Smith (TCR Eligibility Scrutineer). Under force majeure Car 100 is permitted to start in their qualifying position rather than rear of grid.

Car 100 Turbo Change is also documented and falls within the permitted change limits in CR 5.5.5. with no penalty.

The driver of car 100, Steve Laidlaw, was interviewed. Also present Adrian Smith (Scrutineer), Kieron Salmons (Deputy Clerk).
