Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.2 App.1 Art.1.14, Ch.12 App.8 Art.1.7.e/f Failure to comply with yellow signals

Brief Details:

Reported by marshals post to have overtaken car 25 between marshals posts 7.5 and 8.1 whilst a "Live Snatch" was being undertaken. Driver of 127 interviewed, shown the marshals written report and his own video footage reviewed which clearly shows the tele-handler and the stricken car still in the gravel. Yellow light panels, followed by green light panels also clearly seen. The video footage clearly shows the overtaking as described above. The driver of car 25 was not called due to the very clear evidence provided on video. Also present in this hearing were Martin Brinkworth (Dep) and Tim Walker (Asst) You have been advised of your right to appeal my decision.
