Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.2 App.1 Art.1.13 Driving in a manner not compatible with general safety and/or departing from the standard of a reasonably competent driver

Brief Details:

Car 47 approaching the chicane was attempting a pass. 47 was on right side of the track, locked brakes and missed the car alongside and spun after first apex and was stationary across the track and was collected by an unsighted car 51.
Video footage viewed from stream and driver interviewed. Driver of car 47 admits that the incident was his fault. I have elected this regulation as the collision was a secondary element to the incident caused by the lack of control of car 47. I find car car 47 at fault for the incident though lack of control.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Video from stream, no video available from onboard.
