Brief Details:

After starting your race you later pulled into the pitlane and subsequently into the paddock. Some time later, you re-entered the pit lane, and rejoined the circuit.

You were shown a Black flag as work that is not carried out in the pit lane is not allowed. Therefore it is reasonable to assume that by entering the paddock, that you have retired from the session.

You passed the black flag on the start line four (4) times before coming into the pits.
