Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

### **Brief Details:**

Scrutineers Non-Compliance Report received regarding an inoperative Red Warning Light (NCR 7.5.6).

Interviewed the driver of Car 150 with scrutineer Ian Mackinder (400564).

The race conditions were rain/track wet. All competitors were advised through radio to start line communication that Red Warning Lights should be in operation for the race. It was noted during the race that Car 150 was not showing a red warning light, however it cannot be established when or if the light had failed. When Car 150 returned to Parc Ferme after the race finished the scrutineer and the Clerk of the Course were present and it was noted that Car 150 had no visible Red Warning Light.

### **Evidence Relied Upon:**

Scrutineer Non-compliance report.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK NCR Ch.5A App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Be disqualified from the results of the race (Ch.2, App.2 Art 1 (e))
